FACTS	WHAT DOES SOUTHEASTERN ARIZONA FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?	
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Social Security number and name and address information ▪ Account balances and transaction history ▪ Credit History and payment or loss history <p>When you are no longer our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>	
How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Southeastern Arizona Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Southeastern Arizona Federal Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Southeastern Arizona Federal Credit Union collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Open an account or apply for a loan ▪ Conduct transactions or use your Debit or ATM card ▪ Request information about products or services <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness ▪ Affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Southeastern Arizona Federal Credit Union does not have any affiliates.</i>
Non-affiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Southeastern Arizona Federal Credit Union does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you except for our joint marketing arrangements.</i>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Our joint marketing partners include credit card companies, non-financial companies that perform support services.</i>
